**MINUTES OF THE SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
WEDNESDAY, 6:00PM, JUNE 30, 2004**

The quarterly meeting of the Safety Committee was held at the Silverado Community Center. Those attending were Director Hunt and Caretaker Aaron Combs.

The following items relating to safety issues were discussed:

- (1) The gophers in the lawn have been eradicated, and the trip-hazards represented by their holes filled in. Will continue to sand in uneven places in the lawn.
- (2) In response to the recent rattlesnake bite of a dog in Silverado Park, laminated signs in bright colors, with a large coiled rattler in the middle, warning patrons to watch out for snakes have been posted at prominent places in the park. There is little else that we can do for a facility surrounded by open land in an area with a heavy population of snakes, but the caretakers will keep a sharp eye out for them nonetheless. Signs were posted in Modjeska Park as well.
- (3) A letter to the regular users of the Silverado Community Center on the first weekend of each month will be sent asking them to please keep their children out of the trees.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:42PM. Next regular meeting of the Safety Committee will be scheduled at a date to be determined in the third quarter.
