CHILDREN'S CENTER DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Children's Center Director Bryer presented a financial report to the Board. Chili Cook-off is scheduled for April 18th and a Parent Workday is being planned. Losses continue to run about \$1,000.00 a month.

GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Phil McWilliams reported on two bids for the kitchen and restroom work at Silverado Park. The Board will take two weeks to review them, and then have a special meeting to award the contracts. Director Hunt said that the exterior of the Silverado Community Center needs repair and paint because of water damage and should be a priority.

Mr. McWilliams is still seeking approval with county planning for the Solar Panel project. Some problems have delayed the approval process. The grant expires in March. Work will begin on the Silverado asphalt repair and parking lot restriping this month.

OTHER DISTRICT BUSINESS

The Board discussed a potential buyer for Silverado Holtz Ranch property. St Michael's Abbey is interested in purchasing it but will give strong weight to Silverado residents' opinions about it. Director Hunt did a 63-person survey by email and got 13 responses, 10 negative and 3 positive. He has a meeting scheduled with them this week.

The Board was reminded to get their 700 Forms filled out and sent to the Orange County Clerk of the Board before the April 1st deadline.

DIRECTOR COMMENTS:

Director Evans reported that the new Spring brochure is finished and in the mail.

Director Hunt commented on the awards ceremony, thanking Director Levy, Director Evans and Bev Mileham the planning, vision, and hard work.

Director Levy said he hopes to make this an annual event.
