PUBLIC AND BOARD INPUT ON NON-AGENDIZED ITEMS

Lori Martin has been researching projectors, that will be used for community events. Lots of creative ideas and pricing were discussed, Directors Peterson and Collins will help with this and report their findings at the next Board meeting.

Childrens Center report was moved in order to discuss dog park issues (D) first.

(D)

Director Collins said there are complaints about how Modjeska Park is being used. Discussed possibility of calling it a Dog Park under the advise of Capri. This settles liability issues. For safety a fenced in area for the children was an considered. The Board decided to have a special community meeting to get everyone's input and hopefully get ideas to resolve this issue. The meeting will be held May or June.

CHILDRENS'S CENTER REPORT

Children's center Director Aimee Bryer reported no changes in enrollment. Ms. Bryer is working on 3 grants for the center. Chili Cook-off fundraiser is this weekend, and another one at the Great Park July 21st. Advisory committee meeting coming up.

(A)

Director Collins proposed saying the Pledge of Allegiance before Board meetings. The Board and the public loved the idea.

(B)

The Board discussed purchasing AED Allied expeditionary Division Defibulators. Director Collins is researching them and getting bids together. Since there are a lot of events held in the canyons it may be purchased for emergencies. Directors Collins and Peterson will work further on this and report later at another Board meeting.

(C)

The Board discussed purchasing booth materials, banners, EZ -ups for future SMRPD events. Director Collins said she would a like the Board to be available to participate in future events, with community volunteers helping also.

3rd ACTION: Director Smisek made a motion to approve SMRPD to purchase an EZ-up and banner, up to the amount of \$500. Director Peterson seconded. Unanimously approved. (E)

Director Collins was not ready to report on CSDA courses.

(F)

Director Peterson reported, she and Debbie Johnson attended the school Board meeting. The vote was 6-0 to sell to the County and now will go to the Board of Supervisors to have the sale approved. A discussion ensued with the Board and the public asking if SMRPD should be actively involved with a committee that could work with future school site plans. SMRPD may

plan a community meeting to get their input. Another meeting may be planned with the county sharing the communities ideas and recommendations.
