10th Annual Silverado Chili Cook-Off Rules & Regulations

To insure quality and success of our event, we require that the following rules and regulations be strictly followed by all chili booth participants....no exceptions!

1. You must be at least 18 years of age to run a chili booth.
2. **NO CANNED CHILI MAY BE ENTERED IN THE CONTEST!**
3. **NO ALCOHOL MAY BE SOLD OR GIVEN AWAY FROM YOUR BOOTH!** Our event host, Irvine Lake, retains all rights to alcohol as per ABC licensing. *Thank you!!*
4. Contestants may arrive no earlier than 8:00 am. Chili booths must be set-up and ready for cooking by 9:00 am. The cooking period for “Judges Chili” will be a minimum of two hours. Contestants who are late may be disqualified, so please be on time!
5. The SMRPD will provide a 10’X10’ area for each contestant. If you do not own a canopy, you may be able to rent one from SMRPD for an additional fee of \$10. Contestants are responsible for supplying their own cooking equipment, utensils, camping stove, tables, chairs etc. Gas, Propane stoves or BBQs OK, but no electricity will be provided!
6. Each chili booth will be assigned a contestant’s number by the “Chili Chief”.
7. A representative of the booth shall be present at the contestant’s meeting to be held at approximately 10:30 am. (Chili Chief will announce the meeting)
8. Each contestant must also prepare a minimum of “Five Gallons” (onsite or already cooked) of their award winning chili to be judged by the “People’s Choice” tasters. You DO NOT want to run out – it will affect your votes for the People Choices award!
9. If you choose to have your Chili judged by our “Official Chili Judges”, a minimum of two gallons of your award winning chili must be cooked on premises the day of the event. The meat may be treated, pre-cut or ground but the meat for the two gallons of chili may not be pre-cooked! The only exceptions are canned tomatoes, tomato sauce, peppers, pepper sauce, beans, broth, and mixing of spices.
10. The official start time of the chili tasting will be 11am. Official judging will take place at 1 pm. People’s Choice judging will end by 4:00 pm. We will supply the spoons and cups for taste testing. *You may supply any appropriate condiments; onions, cheese, chips, cornbread, crackers, etc. (No alcohol giveaways please!)*
11. Cash award and trophy will be given for the “Judges Choice - Best Chili”, trophy and prizes to “People’s Choice - Best Chili” and “Best Decorated Chili Booth and Chili Team” costume award also! Good Luck to everyone!
