

  
**Silverado** **COOK OFF** **& Cinco de Mayo Festival**  
**Vendor/Exhibitor Agreement**

1. The Silverado Chili Cook-Off will open to exhibitors at 8:00 AM on Saturday, May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017. All Vendors / Exhibitors must check in at the Registration Booth prior to set up and must unload and complete setup by 10:30 am. All vehicles must be removed from the vendor area by 10:30 am. Vendors / Exhibitors can begin teardown at the closing of the event 4:00 pm. Vendors/ Exhibitors must remove all property, and leave their space clean and free of trash and debris.
2. Each space includes the selected, mapped plot and free nearby parking. We recommend that you bring a canopy and any required/preferred table and chairs, as none will be provided. Vendor spaces do not include electricity. In the event of inclement weather, the Silverado Chili Cook-Off barring hazardous conditions will still take place.
3. Booth and rental fees must be paid with application, and are non-refundable. Fees and signed agreement are required for the reservation of any plot no later than Friday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
4. **Each vendor is asked to donate one item or gift certificate to the event Opportunity Drawing upon entry to the expo in support of the SMRPD/SCC.**
5. It is the Vendor / Exhibitor's responsibility to obtain business licenses required by, and pay all fees/taxes to the State of California. Food selling vendors must be authorized by the Orange County Health Care Agency and have a food handler's card or permit.
6. Electricity will be inaccessible for outdoor vendors and exhibitors. Vendors and exhibitors must be prepared to accommodate without use of power. Battery or solar generated electric will be permissible and encouraged.
7. We ask that food sale vendors serve food in recyclable or compostable containers. **Styrofoam and plastic utensils and containers are discouraged.** A goal of the event is to be "eco friendly". Compostables can be easily purchased online or at Smart & Final stores.
8. Vendors / Exhibitors agree that the Silverado-Modjeska Recreation & Park District shall not be liable for any loss to their property in the event of wind, fire, theft or vandalism.
9. Silverado Chili Cook-Off reserves the right to accept or reject any application for booth space. Vendors / Exhibitors agree that the services conducted in their booth shall be supportive and appropriate to the purposes of the Silverado-Modjeska Recreation & Park District (SMRPD).
10. Vendors / Exhibitors agree to indemnify and hold harmless the SMRPD, its directors, staff, volunteers, agents against any and all claims (including attorney's fees) imposed on, incurred by, asserted against any of the parties mentioned above, caused by any act or omission of anyone, or occurring within the vendors / exhibitors booth space, or arising in connection with the activities conducted by the vendor / exhibitor with the Silverado Chili Cook-Off.
