## MINUTES OF THE SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 2004 AT 9:30PM

The quarterly meeting of the Safety Committee was held at the Silverado Community Center. Those attending were Director Hunt and Director Johnson.

The following items relating to safety issues were discussed:

- (1) The previous problems of children climbing in trees has ceased following a request to their parents to more closely supervise them. There have been no additional problems with snake bites or sightings. The snake warning signs are still in place
- (2) The Canyon School of the Arts reported a defective wall socket for the air conditioner, and a defective phone, both being described as safety problems. Without debating that issue for the phone, instructions were issued to the Caretaker to repair both immediately. This was accomplished prior to the typing of these minutes.
- (3) There is a broken window in the men's outdoor restroom at Silverado Park that will require special equipment purchase, the window is not a standard one.
- (4) There is a cracked fire sprinkler pipe at the Silverado Children's Center. Arrangements have been made to repair same.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:00PM. Next regular meeting of the Safety Committee will be scheduled at a date to be determined in the fourth quarter.
