CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM by Director Hunt who acted as chairperson.

ROLL CALL

PUBLIC AND BOARD INPUT ON NON-AGENDIZED ITEMS

Phil McWilliams said that there will be an All Canyons and All Coastal Cleanup in September 2009 and requested that the Board consider a donation since funding is way down.

CONSENT CALENDAR

1st ACTION: Director Evans made a motion to approve the Minutes of the Regular Board meeting of June 23, 2009, the July 9, 2009 Special Board Meeting, and Correspondence. Director Peterson seconded. Unanimously approved.

PAYMENT OF DISTRICT BILLS

2nd ACTION: Director Evans made a motion to approve Transmittal 07-09A for Directors compensation for the Regular Board meeting of June 23, 2009, \$150 total. Director Peterson seconded. Unanimously approved.

3rd ACTION: Director Peterson made a motion to approve payment of Transmittal 07-09B District Bills, \$ 2,155.93 total. Director Weel seconded. Unanimously approved.

4th ACTION: Director Evans made a motion to approve payment of Transmittal 07-09C, Utility Bills and reimbursements, \$1,692.24 total. Director Weel seconded. Unanimously approved.

CHILDREN'S CENTER DIRECTOR'S REPORT

SCC Director Aimee Bryer gave the Board financials to review. Enrollments and Staff are unchanged. The summer program is going well. The budget is now being sent to and reviewed by Directors on a weekly basis. The \$15,000 dollar Grant check will be arriving by the end of the week. Director Bryer will discuss with the Board how she plans to apply the funds for the Center. The Fall Program is being planned and will be discussed with the Board. An increase in tuition rates will be considered at the August 25, 2009 SMRPD Regular Board Meeting.

GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

The Board discussed the Solar Panel Project and decided to reopen the bidding process that was halted because of frozen funds. The state now indicates that it is OK to proceed.

5th ACTION: Director Hunt made a motion to reopen the Solar Panel Project bidding process. Director Evans seconded. Unanimously approved.

OTHER DISTRICT BUSINESS

The Board wishes to commend Supervisor Campbell and county Staff for their assistance and cooperation with incorporating community suggestions for a rural appearance into the recent rework of two bridges on Santiago Canyon Road.

6th ACTION: Director Hunt made a motion to draw up **Resolution 072809-1** commending Supervisor Campbell and County Staff. Director Evans seconded. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN Director Evans, Aye; Director Hunt, Aye; Director Peterson, Aye; Director Weel, Aye.

7th ACTION: Director Weel made a motion to accept the engagement letter from Richard L. Hale & Company, Public Accountant, for the SMRPD FY 2008-2009 Audit, for fees not to exceed \$8,450. Director Peterson seconded. Unanimously approved.

The Inter-Canyon League was given permission by OUSD to remove the Blue Light Mine Ore-Cart that was previously donated by ICL for display at Silverado School. ICL Director Colgan asked the Board if SMRPD would in turn accept it and display or store it in a safe location. The Directors agreed and will most likely put it at the Silverado Center. Ways to avoid theft and vandalism were discussed. It will need to be securely mounted to a solid, immovable base.

DIRECTORS COMMENTS

Director Evans said Mary Schreiber donated water for hikes held by the Recreation Program. Music in the Park events are going well. Director Evans will attend the ISDOC meeting this Thursday, and President Hunt designated her the official ISDOC representative for SMRPD.
