Public Comments:

Jo Marie Varela: Noted that Alex is working on website updates to ensure compliance.

Phil McWilliams: Noted that the distinction between recommended and required for ADA compliance on the website.

b. Self-Assessment – status update

Public Comments:

Phil McWilliams: Noted that any updates to the facility after 2012, falls under the 1991 requirements under Safe Harbor. Advised that in the past Capri would be more open to self-assessments but noted a shift in Capri's risk assessment. SMRPD facilities are protected by the grandfather clause, and as a smaller district, SMRPD has less funds for lawsuits. Overall, the facilities are accessible. Discussed Modjeska trails being grandfathered in, but if trails are upgraded portions of them may need to be made up to current ADA compliance standards.

Steve Reighart: Advised that in the past, we have had community members that were ADA advocates.

Phil McWilliams: Confirmed that the Silverado self-assessment is complete, and Modjeska will be completed by February meeting. Discussed ideas for Silverado Community Center, including; signage indicating ADA accessibility, audio alarm for exit requirements, and Modjeska signage. Phil McWilliams: Advised that the ceramics group noticed paving issues between the driveway and IRWD's areas.

Board Comments:

Director Conklin: Noted that we are regularly inspected for compliance. Inquired as to the recommendations for Silverado. Requested a reminder to check in with IRWD for an update on the Modjeska paving.

Director Martz: Inquired about a trail on Modjeska's accessibility. Requested levels be assigned for each recommendation once self-assessment completed.
